An opportunity for a chat and to browse our newly launched library section where you can borrow, swap or buy any of the books available.



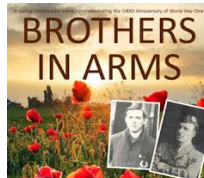
7 October - a return visit by the very popular **Rossendale Scout Group Band**. This was a big success last year and we are delighted to welcome them back.

Venue - in The Greenhouse in the church car park.

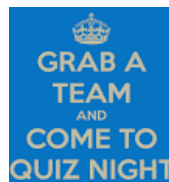
